- Pinch salt
- 6 ozs Demerara sugar
- 6 ozs margarine
- 10 ozs dried fruit
- Grated rind of an orange
- 1 large beaten egg
- ¼ pint cider
- 2 level tablespoons marmalade

7" square/ 8" round lined tin. Oven 170 °C.

Sift flour and salt into a bowl, add sugar and rub in margarine. Stir in the dried fruit and orange rind. Make a well in the centre and add the egg, cider and marmalade. Stir the mixture until really well mixed. Bake for 1 ¼ hours, till firm to the touch.
