- HO3      **“Foliage is Beautiful”** an arrangement of foliage (not all green). Width allowed 2 feet. – height unlimited.
- HO4      **“The Power of Simplicity”** – a contemporary arrangement of fresh flowers and foliage. Width allowed 2 feet, height unlimited. Accessories allowed.
- HO5      **“Breakfast Tray Arrangement”** – an arrangement of flowers and foliage. Overall space not to exceed 9 inches.
- HO6      **“Golden Rays of Summer”** An arrangement of fresh flowers and foliage incorporating fruit and/or vegetables. Width allowed 2 feet height unlimited.
- HO7      **“A Buffet Meal”** an arrangement of fresh flowers and foliage suitable for a buffet table. Space allowed 2 feet height unlimited.
- HO8      **“Unusual Container”** An arrangement of fresh flowers and foliage in an unusual container – maximum width 2 feet, height unlimited.
- HO9      **“Perfect Solo”** An arrangement of 1 bloom, any foliage incorporating driftwood. Width allowed 18 inches, height unlimited.
